Individual Event Top Ten winners will be awarded a GNF Ribbon on site and will be immediately put on display until the end of the 2019 GNF in the Youth and Education Exhibits in our section. **Any top 10 entry not left for display will be disqualified and lose the place as well as the monetary award. Lower places will then be moved up accordingly.** A cash award will be mailed to the school in the following amounts per event. Individual event award checks will be made out to the student registered and team events will be made out to the school chapter.

Metro chapters can make arrangements to pick the entries/awards up at the Locust Grove Office. Any entries not claimed by Christmas Break will be discarded, but ribbons will be saved.
