Scholarship Policies and Qualifications

- Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or above.
- Applicants must be or have been an active member of TSA.
- Applicants must have applied to and be accepted by or already in attendance at a college or university in Georgia.
- Recipient must major in an Engineering or STEM Education degree program.
- The GA TSA office handles funds in the following manner: \$1000.00 will be payable to the winner or winners of the scholarship upon receipt of an official acceptance letter and a course schedule is provided to GA TSA.
- The scholarship application will not be considered without all requested documents.

The completed scholarship application and all necessary documents should be made into a multipage pdf document (in the following order) and uploaded to the proper link in the Event Management System.
